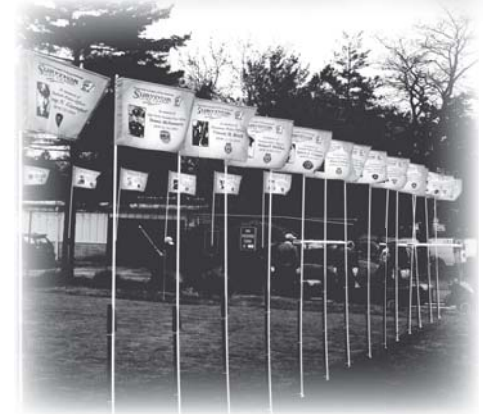

GSC.O.P.S. also provides training to law enforcement agencies on survivor victimization issues and educates the public of the need to support the law enforcement profession and its survivors. Besides having fun, the main reason for having our annual golf tournament is to raise funds for our organization, so we need all the financial help we can get! This is your opportunity to be part of something very important. One way is to sponsor a hole and we'll put a sign up for you at that hole. Hole sponsorships are \$100.00. Remember a Fallen Officer with the “Remembrance Flag”

Our vision is to honor every officer killed in the line of duty in New Jersey, and their department, by creating a “Remembrance Walkway” at the Tournament. The “Remembrance Flags will line the registration area and golf course.

These flags are beautifully printed in full color. The flags include a picture of the officer, the department name and emblem, and the officer’s End of Watch.

Flags measure 14” x 20” and are made of durable material just like the pin flags used on every golf course.



Our hope is that individual departments, PBA locals, FOP lodges and/or families will purchase a “Remembrance Flag” to honor an officer killed in the line of duty. This endeavor may take a few years to complete, but the goal is to have one flag to honor every officer.

Sponsors, departments and families have the option to purchase additional flags to keep. The additional flags may be purchased at a discount rate at the time the initial order is placed for the first flag.
